REQUEST FOR QUOTE TREE MAINTENANCE SUMMER 2025 NOTES FROM SITE VISITS ON JUNE 9 AND 10, 2025

- Q. Are all the trees flagged?
- A. No. Although we have tried to flag everything with orange flagging tape, there are areas where the work in obvious, long stretches of just trimming back to property line and/or that the flagging was removed by residents. Flagging was updated during the site visits over the last two days.
- Q. Do all locations have septic tanks?
- A. No. The locations with one (or two for 5-bedroom homes) septic tanks are Alachua/Merrillwood, Alachua/Hitchcock, Newberry/Meadowbrook, Archer/Thistle Hills East, Archer/Thistle Hills West and Waldo/Pine Tree Terrace. Further, the only active use of the septic tanks is in Archer and these have drain fields (some with lift stations) that need to be taken into consideration. The Director of Maintenance will work with the awarded contractor to ensure the locations are noted prior to commencement of work.
- Q. Do you have any buried gas tanks?
- A. Yes. There are LP gas tanks in the Alachua, Newberry, Archer and Waldo neighborhoods. The Director of Maintenance will work with the awarded contractor to ensure the locations are noted prior to commencement of work.
- Q. Are all stumps to be ground? This could really increase costs.
- A. It is our intention to have all stumps ground. However, we've added a line for a "discount" for cutting the stump to ground level (in order for a mower to go across) in place of grinding. See new pricing sheet on page 9 of this RFQ.
- Q. Are permits required?
- A. Yes. Please see the "Notes" addendum as listed on the ACHA website. ACHA has made a concerted effort to have all the locations checked by the appropriate agency. The notes page lists these efforts. The City of Gainesville has issued permits for their locations. It is the responsibility of the awarded contractor to make sure the required permits are secured and accounted for in the costs of the quote submitted. Department.pdf

- Q. Who is responsible for mitigation and tree replacement costs?
- A. ACHA has requested clarification on the mitigation costs responsibility from HUD. We have not received an answer as of date. We have placed a few lines on the quote sheet for you to address any known mitigations costs.
- Q. Are there any changes to the list of work from the RFQ?

- Q. If we grind the stumps, do we need to remove the ground up material?
- A. All ground up material and cut tree debris must be removed. Further, all areas need to be raked out, vehicle and equipment rutting repaired and repairs completed on any broken concrete or asphalt.
- Q. Will we be able to get interim payments?
- A. Yes. Please provide the two parts of the quote sheets with your submission. We will use these to make periodic estimated payments for fully completed work.
